DRAGONS ARE COMING!

Dragon's Horde is approaching! Draconis and his evil minions will once again attempt to despoil the gem of Atenveldt! All are invited by the Barony of Tir Ysgithr to this glorious event. Dragon's Horde will once again be a two-day event with Feast on Saturday evening! Expect frequent appearances from Draconis' oh so pleasant ambassador.

Saturday (10/24)

Following opening court, there will be a monster tourney (double elimination), where each team will pit their monster against another team's monster. Teams must be sponsored by a household and each household can have more than one team. Any weapon style may be used. The winning household will receive a special prize to be displayed until the next Dragon's Horde event.

After the monster tourney, there will be a Fighting Clinic for hard suit and rapier fighters. All participating fighters will have an opportunity to fight against peers of their order. Opening court will be at 10:30, closing court will be held at the time of Their Excellencies choosing.

Saturday Night (10/24)

A Medieval Basque Feast for 80 will be offered. Site opens at 6:00 p.m. Feast will be served starting at 6:30 p.m. The cap is e, period entertainment, and MORE. Feast will be served family style and the site is wet. Side board and special dietary needs should be discussed directly with the Feastocrat and will be accommodated if possible. More information regarding feast, including menu, will be provided closer to the event.

Court will be held at Their Excellencies discretion.

Feast registration will be through the BTY Seneschal Officers (Mistress Anya and Mistress Tigr) only. Deadline for Feast reservations and payment is 10/10/15. Payment can be made via check or cash. You may register with either of them at Fighter practice, upcoming events, or contact via Seneschal@btysca.org to make other arrangements.

Sunday (10/25)

The White and Red Dragons will attempt to feast upon the bones of our steadfast hardsuit combatants while the Green Dragon snacks on our youth fighters. For our rapier fighters the evil Kraken will attempt to destroy all challengers!

To finish, there will be a Grand Melee. The white dragon and his minions (the winners of the monster tourney) will descend on the villagers (i.e.: the rest of the heavy fighters). Villagers will use torches (single sword) and pitchforks (pole-arm) to defend themselves.

Opening court will be at 10:30, closing court will be held at Their Excellencies discretion.

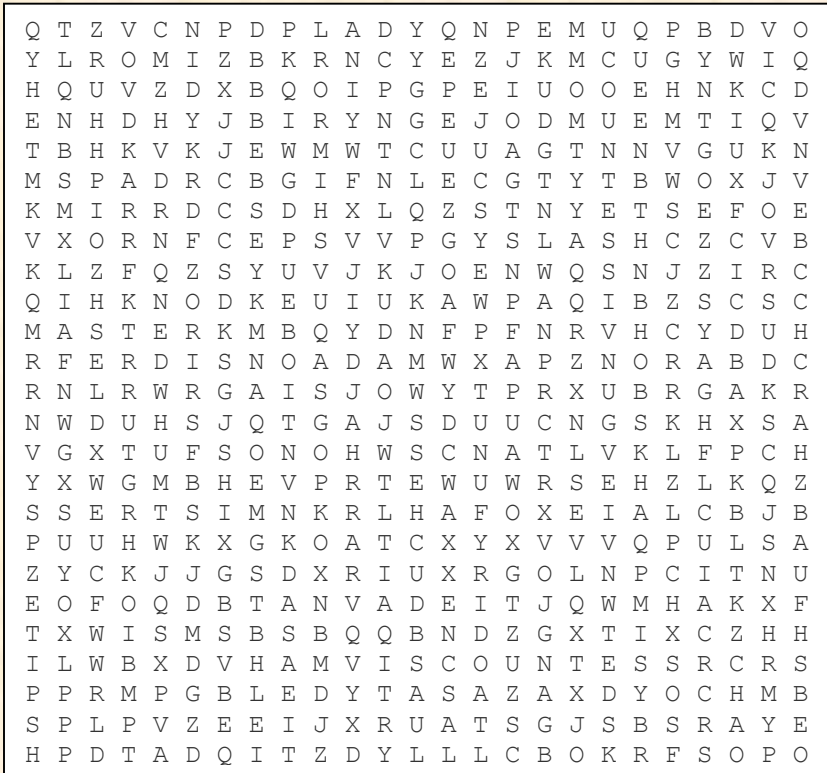

Who Are They?

Many titles are used frequently throughout the Barony, but how many of them do you know and recognize? And how can you tell who is who based on appearance? It's simpler than one might think!

King and Queen

Rulers of the Kingdom, chosen by combat every 4-6 months.

-What they wear: The King and Queen of Atenveldt wear Crowns of precious metals, of such size, construction, and ornamentation as pleases them.

-How to address them: "Your Majesty" It is customary to curtsy when first addressing a King or Queen or when passing Them.

Crown Prince and Princess

Heirs to the Kingdom, chosen by combat. They hold this title after winning the Crown Tourney until their coronation as King and Queen.

-What they wear: A Crown of precious metals, of such size, construction, and ornamentation as pleases them.

-How to address them: "Your Royal Highness"

Duke and Duchess

A Lord or Lady who has reigned twice or more as King and/or Queen.

-What they wear: A coronet of precious metals, embellished with strawberry leaves and ornamented as they see fit. Dukes have an exclusive right to wear gold spurs.

-How to address them: "Your Grace," or "Duke / Duchess (their personal name)"

Count and Countess

A Lord or Lady who has reigned once as King or Queen.

-What they wear: A coronet of precious metals, embattled, and ornamented as they see fit

-How to address them: "Your Excellency" or "Count /Countess (their personal name)".

Viscount and Viscountess

A Lord or Lady who has served as Prince or Princess of a Principality.

-What they wear: Coronets of precious metals ornamented as they see fit, with a single point at the front which shall not exceed two and one half (2.5") inches.

-How to address them: "Your Excellency" or "Viscount/Viscountess (their personal name)".

Baron and Baroness

Rulers of a Barony

-What they wear: A coronet of precious metals, with ornamentation appropriate to their Barony, with six points embellished with spheroids, pearls, or precious stones. Or a coronet of precious metals with a single large point at the front, with ornamentation appropriate to their Barony. In either case, the overall height of the Coronet shall not exceed two and one half (2.5") inches including the spheroids.

-How to address them: "Your Excellency" or "Baron/Baroness (their personal name)".

Knight (Order of Chivalry)

A Lord or Lady who has shown great ability on the field and for their constant courtesy and chivalry. Knights swear fealty to the Crown and are considered to be vassals of the King.

-What they wear: A white belt, a gold chain, and spurs (all **except** gold).

-How to address them: “Sir”- no matter what other titles they hold, **always** include “Sir”. I.E. Viscount Sir (their personal name)

Master at Arms

A Lord or Lady who has shown great ability on the field and for their constant courtesy and chivalry. Equivalent to a Knight, but does not swear fealty to the Crown.

-What they wear: A white baldric

-How to address them: “Master” or “Mistress”

Laurel (Order of the Laurel)

A Lord or Lady recognized for outstanding excellence and teaching in the arts and/or sciences.

-What they wear: A collar of estate composed of their cypher and elements of their arms, bearing the badges of their Order and Awards.

-How to address them: “Master” or “Mistress”.

Pelican (Order of the Pelican)

A Lord or Lady recognized for continual, extraordinary service to the Kingdom by being accepted into the Order of the Pelican.

-What they wear: A collar of estate composed of their cypher and elements of their arms, bearing the badges of their Order and Awards.

-How to address them: “Master” or “Mistress”

Master and Mistress of Defense (Order of Defense)

A Lord or Lady who has shown great ability on the field and for their constant courtesy and chivalry.

-What they wear: A white livery collar, bearing the badge of the Order of Defense

-How to address them: “Master” or “Mistress”

Defenders of the White Scarf

A Lord or Lady who has shown excellence in defense with the rapier, courtly graces, and provided great service.

-What they wear: A White Scarf worn on the left shoulder. It can be decorated with simple trim in the subject's own heraldic colors and clasped with a sun in its splendor Or.

How to address them: “Your Honorable Lordship” or “Your Honorable Ladyship”

Award of Arms

Grants the right to display your personal arms.

-How to address them: “Lord” or “Lady”
