Barony of Tír Ysgithr's Boast & Toast

Date: Saturday, July 16, 2016

Time: Registration time 9:00 AM

Bring your sommelier cup and a clean pallet. Crews will be working together to share period pot-tages, breads, and brews all while bending your ear with stories of inspiration and artisanship.

Two fully equipped ramadas await you, complete with drinking water, six huge charcoal barbeques w/ pole for lantern, electricity, bear proof food and trash container and tables with seating. Paved road right up to the site!

Cast your voting token into the box of the crew that best makes their impression on you. Perhaps it was how well they please your pallet. Perhaps their pageantry and décor pushes them over the top. Perhaps it was their bard that boasts best for them in the toast. It will be up to you to decide who has best demonstrated their prowess of the arts this day. Bring your feast gear and help clean-up the left -overs.

Feeling tough? Think you got what it takes to fight uphill, in hard suit, in high altitude (8000 feet)? Then this unique king of the hill battle is for you! Gather at Ramada #5 at 10 AM. Fighters will be divided into two teams. Team #1 defends the top of the hill and Team #2 charges up the hill to claim it for their own. Point goes to the team that claims the top of the hill. Team # 2 then becomes the defenders and Team #1 assaults the hill. The winner is two out of three. Bragging and brews to the winning team!

Not to be denied, the above scenario will play out again, at 4 PM, except this time for the Rapier community.

Location: Sites 4 & 5 of the Whitetail loop on Mount Lemon.

Parking & Carpooling

On-site parking is very limited. Carpooling is a must in order to allow for the maximum people to attend. One parking permit, for one parking space, can be obtained through pre-registration. Permits are on a first come- first issued basis while parking spaces are available and you must carpool with at least two other people, to qualify.

Pre-registration begins on June 14, 2016. Permits can be obtained by contacting Lady Maria Isobel Falcon de la Sierra, either by phone or email (see contact information listed below) and will be made available at Tír Ysgithr's Tuesday night's fighter practice.

Parking in any other area on the mountain, in order to attend this event is not allowed by the Forest

Service. Violators will be fined and their vehicles towed by the Sheriff's office.

Should you not be able to obtain a parking space, and wish to attend, please contact the Site Steward on or before July 1st. Arrangements can be made with Her Excellency for shuttle service.

Camping

There is space for modern tents for the night of Saturday the 16th, on a first-come first-serve basis. There are a number of 15 FT wide X 24 FT long designated flat camping surfaces, which will typically hold three to four modern tents each. You may also use any other space within sites Four and Five. Come early to claim your spot!

Fires are limited to the two group fire circles provided in the designated areas surrounding sites four and five. No ground fires. Fire restrictions may be in effect. Pets must be on a leash at all times. All food must be stored in provided bear proof containers overnight and all trash disposed of in provided bear proof trash containers.

Monsoon activity is possible, prepare for wet weather and possible cooler nighttime temperatures.

The altitude is 8000 feet. If you have breathing problems please bring needed medication/equipment.

The site must be vacated by 11 AM on Sunday, July 17, 2016.

Directions:

From the North of Tucson (Phoenix): take I-10 to Exit 256 and onto W Grant Road. Travel East for 5.1 miles until turning left onto E Tanque Verde. Travel 3.3 miles until you reach E Catalina Highway. Turn left (North). In 4.5 miles, Catalina Hwy will turn into E Mt. Lemmon Hwy. From there it will be 20.7 miles before you see Whitetail Rd on the left. We are at the end Whitetail road.

From the South of Tucson (Sierra Vista): take I-10 to Exit 275 to S Houghton Rd. Travel North for 15.1 miles until turning right onto E Catalina Highway. In 2.4 miles, Catalina Hwy will turn into E

Mt. Lemmon Hwy. From there it will be 20.7 miles before you see Whitetail Rd on the left. We are at the end Whitetail road.

Summerhaven, at the top of Mt. Lemmon has a General Store, in case you forgot something of dire importance. Emergency services are provided by the Mt. Lemmon Fire Department and the Pima County Sherriff's Department, and can be reached by dialing 911. Estimated response time 5 to 7 minutes.
